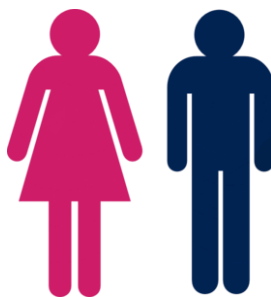
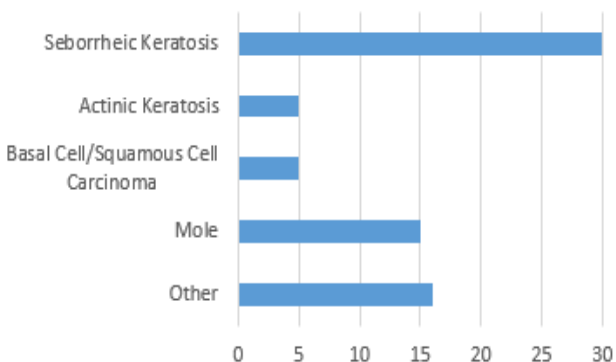
In addition to the screenings our volunteers distributed over 1,000 sunscreen samples, along with UV detecting bracelets, and pamphlets about the importance of sun safety.



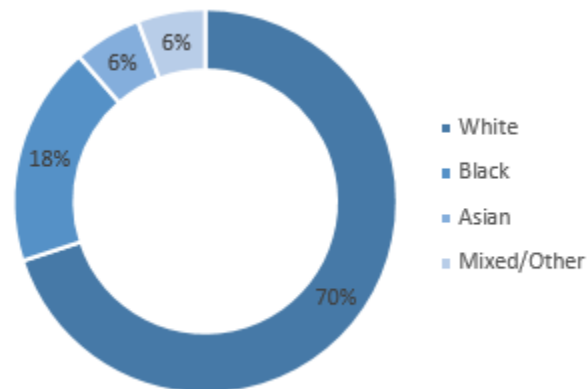
