The Women's Dermatologic Society (WDS) invites you to <u>submit abstracts</u> for their educational sessions (oral presentations and posters) at the 2026 WDS Forum, where members come together for unique education, relationship-building, and a sense of personal and professional renewal. More information about WDS and the Forum can be found on the WDS website as it becomes available.

All dermatology topics are welcome; however, special consideration will be given to those that promote the WDS mission to empower and connect members to advance women dermatologists through personal and professional development, mentorship, service, and leadership.

Educational Session Types

- Oral Presentations provide authors with an opportunity to succinctly share information or research findings to
 a diverse group of experts in the field. Each oral presentation will be 5 minutes with time for questions at the
 end of the session.
- Poster Presentations provide authors with an opportunity to succinctly showcase information or research findings
 to a diverse group of experts in the field. The posters will be available during the one-hour poster crawl.

Submission Guidelines

Abstracts must be free of commercial bias or promotion, and should include the following elements:

- Clear and concise title (25-word limit)
- Identify the educational session type
- Measurable learning objectives
- Description, including background, methods, results, and conclusions (500-word limit)

Selection Criteria

Abstracts will be reviewed and scored based on the following criteria:

- Scientific Merit and Innovation
- Relevance to Dermatology and WDS Mission
- Clarity and Quality of Abstract
- Data Quality and Analysis
- Impact and Applicability
- Presentation Preference and Suitability

Please Note:

- WDS membership is not a requirement for abstract submission.
- WDS strives to conduct a fair review process by utilizing a double-blind approach to limit biases.
- Abstracts previously presented or published will not be accepted.
- Abstract publication in the International Journal of Women's Dermatology (IJWD) <u>may</u> be offered to the 5 highest scoring oral presentations.
- All authors will be required to register for and attend the Forum.
- All authors will be notified in late October/early November 2025.
